November 28, 2006

A Regular Meeting of the Redford Township Board was held on Tuesday, November 28, 2006, in the Board Room of the Redford Township Hall, 15145 Beech Daly. This Regular Meeting was called to order by Supervisor R. Miles Handy, II, at 7:00 p.m.

CITIZENS' COMMENTS:

Maria Marino, 8932 Wormer, asked who was presently managing Coventry Place and asked why workers were there measuring?

Supervisor Handy said they were getting ready to do an addition.

Maria asked why because when they originally built they were told they could not build any bigger or any higher because of the sewer system and because it is a residential area. Also, Lenore has a sign that says no commercial trucks so Wormer gets all the residential and commercial traffic. She also asked if the Township could put a notice in with the water bills informing residents that there is an ordinance requiring residents to pick up their pet feces? She has a problem with a neighbor letting their dog run loose, depositing on her property, and not picking it up.

Supervisor Handy said that John Selmi in the Water Department will be looking into the sewer system and the Building Department can tell her exactly what any plans are for Coventry Place.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Trustee Kobylarz distributed a flier to the Board regarding a 2007 Survey that the Safe Drinking Water Act requires the EPA to conduct every four years to estimate 20-year capital investment needs of public water systems eligible to receive Drinking Water State Revolving Fund assistance. This flier lists 65 of the Michigan systems serving more than 3,300 that were selected to participate in this 2007 Needs Survey. She wants the Board to be aware that Redford Township is one of the 65 listed on this 2007 Survey and that it is very important that those selected systems complete their survey so Michigan can obtain its fair share of the State Revolving Fund appropriations. The Survey material will be addressed to the Township Administrative contact and not directly to the Water Department so the Township needs to be watching for this survey and get the appropriate people assigned to this project so hopefully Redford Township will receive a portion of these revolving funds.




