
Supervisor Handy spoke to issues facing the Township in this next budget year that we need to be aware of; SBT replacement shortfall of about 1.9 billion dollars, franchise fees regarding local cable which could cause a shortfall of one-half million dollars, reduced investments, increased commercial and industrial bankruptcies, local SEV values that could be reduced by the Board of Review causing reduced taxes based on property values, and revenue sharing losses to local government due to the 2007 sunset rule.

The Supervisor called this meeting to ask Board members to begin today getting involved in the budget input rather than waiting until the last minute.

After brief questions and no further discussion, the Supervisor entertained a motion to close this Study Session.

Motion by SIVYER, supported by MCRAE, that we adjourn this Study Session. Motion carried unanimously. This Study Session adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
