



# Arthur S. Bork


## Certificate of Recognition


- WHEREAS: Art Bork was born May 11, 1924 to Bernard and Agnes Bork, the 6<sup>th</sup> of 9 children; and,
- WHEREAS: Art graduated from Northeastern High School in June 1942 and began working as a machine operator at the Fisher Body Plant; and,
- WHEREAS: Art enlisted in the Army-Air Force in December 1942 hoping to be a pilot. Instead, due to vision issues and a proficiency in math, he became a navigator and flew on 35 successful B-17 missions from England over Germany between November 1944 and March 1945; and,
- WHEREAS: After his honorable discharge as a second lieutenant in 1945, Art returned to Hamtramck and, using the GI Bill, completed his degree as an architect at the University of Detroit in 1948; and,
- WHEREAS: That same year, Art started his career at Ford Motor Company, and married his sweetheart, Margaret. In September 1949 their first child, Marlene was born, followed by a son, Paul in 1953; and,
- WHEREAS: having outgrown their apartment, Art and Margaret moved to their first home on Delaware Street in Redford Township in 1954 and their son, Robert was born in 1956; and,
- WHEREAS: Although illness claimed the life of Margaret in 1960, Art continued to make Redford Township his community and home, all three children attending Our Lady of Loretto School with the boys graduating from Redford Union High School and Marlene from Our Lady of Mercy High School; and,
- WHEREAS: Throughout his life in Redford Township, Art has been a parishioner at Our Lady of Loretto, a member of the Knights of Columbus and, until recently, was a regular league bowler at Beech Lanes and a frequent golfer at Glenhurst Golf Club; and




