



**PROCLAMATION**  
**REDFORD SUBURBAN LEAGUE WEEK**  
October 13 - 19, 2013

- WHEREAS:** the Redford Suburban League is a local philanthropic organization which began from a membership of 43 in 1955 and has continued to encourage hundreds of women over the span of 58 years to create a legacy of impact; and
- WHEREAS:** the League has raised and disbursed more than a half million dollars in purposeful and effective charitable enterprises for the mentally and physically handicapped children and other community interests; and
- WHEREAS:** the women of the Redford Suburban League provide excellent role models to the young women in our community through their sense of community and activism; and
- WHEREAS:** the League has merited and received awards such as the "Heart of Gold" in 1970 from Tri-County United Foundation; Boys' Club of Metro Detroit Key Award for Outstanding Community Service, 1976-1977; service award from Penrickton Center for Blind Children in 1979-80; Special Tribute letter from Governor William Milliken, 1979; and in 2006 a Special Resolution from Wayne County Commissioner Philip Cavanagh; and
- WHEREAS:** noteworthy among the League's varied and successful money-raising activities are: publishing and sale of Mrs. America Cookbook in honor of the Mrs. America 1961-62, a charter member of the League; sale of "The Binkie Book", book and record combinations written by League members; more than 20 years of musical comedies written and produced by League members; thirty-six consecutive fashion shows featuring celebrity models and most recently the "Warm Up America" project which takes donated 7x9 squares and turns them into afghans for children's hospitals, local shelters and Redford Interfaith Relief; and
- WHEREAS:** in commemoration of Redford Township Suburban League Week, the League will celebrate their anniversary during the week of October 13; and
- WHEREAS:** proceeds from their many fundraising events throughout the year will be used for the benefit of the Burger School for Children with Autism.






