

The special meeting of the **Charter Township of Redford Park Commission** was held on March 22, 2006 at the Northwest Branch of the YWCA. The meeting was called to order at 6:45PM.

Beverly Chisolm and Butch Streeter from the Y gave a tour of the facility located at 25940 Grand River Avenue.

The building was built in 1959 by architect Yamasaki whose vision was to have the environment be part of the structure. All rooms have storage. All windows are egress and open out. There is an intercom system throughout that does not function. There are four separate boilers in the building. There is no fire/sprinkler system but there is a security system. The roof was completely replaced in the early 1990's but there are still issues with it. Also the phone system is troubled.

The indoor pool was built in 1970 and it has been closed four years. The decking needs to be replaced but the equipment is in good shape. It costs approximately \$100,000 yearly to operate the pool.

Other sites are available in the township and we must investigate financially and geographically what would be the best choice. The Y would operate around our lease requirements. The current tenants are on a month to month lease.
