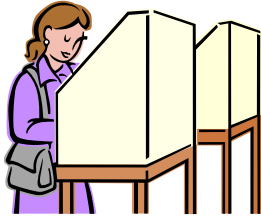

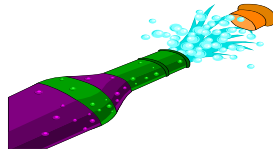

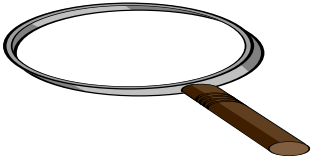

Prevent Frozen Pipes

The Redford Township Water and Sewer Department reminds residents & business owners to take steps now to prevent their water pipes from freezing and breaking during the winter months.

Disconnect & drain outdoor hoses. If there is a shutoff inside the house for the outdoor spigot, turn it off and drain the spigot.

Insulate pipes or faucets in unheated areas of your home. Also, remember to insulate water pipes in crawl spaces.

Water customers may choose to allow a trickle of water to run through one faucet to keep the water lines moving during a cold snap.

Determine where the master valve for your water is in case pipes freeze and rupture. Common locations for the valve in your house or building are where the water supply enters your home, near your washer hookup or near your water heater.
