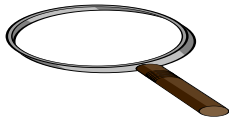

Redford Township Snow Removal

The Department of Public Services reminds all residents to follow these guidelines:

All sidewalks and driveways in front of their homes (and similar paved areas for public use) must be kept free of all accumulation of snow, ice and mud.

Local ordinances do not allow for piling, or depositing snow on your neighbor's property, streets, alleys or public right of way.

When a Snow Emergency is called by the Wayne County, all vehicles should be removed from the streets. Wayne County has established priorities for snow removal throughout the county? The first roads to be cleaned are the expressways. Second to be cleaned are the main roads (Telegraph, Plymouth, Grand River and the Mile Roads). Third to be cleaned are the school bus routes as designated by the two school districts. Lastly, residential streets are plowed (if four or more inches of snow are present). Remember, the county cannot plow the street if cars are parked on them.
