ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD LOCATED IN WAYNE COUNTY, AND TO DESIGNATE REGULATED FLOOD HAZARD AREAS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD ORDAINS:

1. That the Redford Charter Township Code is hereby amended by adding a Section, to be numbered by the Code Administrator, which Section reads as follows:

Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Director of Public Services of the Charter Township of Redford is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Redford under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Charter Township of Redford assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8(b)(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Charter Township of Redford.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Wayne County, Michigan (All jurisdictions)" and dated 2/2/12 and the Flood insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26163C, 0054E, 0060E, 0062E, 0064E, 0066E, 0067E, 0068E, 0069E, 0227E, 0231E and 0232E dated 2/2/12 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3

of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

2. Repeal. All articles, resolutions, orders, or other ordinances in the Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Redford in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of any such conflict, hereby repealed.
3. Savings Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be recorded by the Township Clerk and shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Charter Township of Redford within ten days after its passage and shall take effect immediately upon publication.




