ORDINANCE NO. 322

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 42-51 OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADOPT THE 2009 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE INCLUDING APPENDIX CHAPTERS B, C, D, F, AND I.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD HEREBY ORDAINS:

1. That Section 42-51 of the Charter Township of Redford Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

The 2009 International Fire Code including Appendix Chapters B, C, D, F, and I, three copies of which are on file in the office of the township clerk, as published by the International Code Council, is adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the Charter Township of Redford for regulating and governing the safeguarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and each and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such International Fire Code, 2009 Edition, published by the International Code Council, on file in the office of the township clerk are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this article.

2. Repeal. All Ordinances, resolution or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.
3. Savings Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
4. Authority. The adoption of the Ordinance is done under the authority of Act No. 246 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 1945 (MCL 41.181 et. seq.), as amended, and shall apply to all lands within the corporate limits of the Township and beyond where provided by law. It is needed to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township.
5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be recorded by the Township Clerk and shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Charter Township of Redford within ten days after its passage and shall take effect immediately upon publication.




