



Redford residents may now recycle their used household batteries throughout the year in the lobby of the Public Services Building at 12200 Beech Daly.

Acceptable types of batteries are:

**D, C, AA & AAA cells
button cells**

9 volt

any other dry - cell battery

rechargeables from cell phones, cameras, laptops



******Important Note: All rechargeable batteries must have the positive ends covered with clear tape before being deposited in our collection bin to prevent an incident such as a fire. This is a US Dept of Transportation (DOT) requirement. Also, small "button" batteries should be lined up on a strip of clear tape and secured with another strip of clear tape along the top.***

Important Notice to Redford Twp. Residents Who Deposit Used Batteries at the Redford Public Services Building

All rechargeable batteries (usually marked *NiCad*, *Ni-MH*, *Li-ion*, or *silver-oxide button* batteries) must have the positive ends covered with clear tape before depositing them in this collection bin. Small “**button batteries**” may be lined up on a strip of clear tape and secured with another strip of clear tape along the top. This is a US Department of Transportation (DOT) requirement to prevent major incidents, such as fires which can start from the contact of rechargeable batteries with other batteries that may still be holding a partial charge.

Regular alkaline batteries do not need to be taped.

Tape is available at the Water or Building Department windows should you need it.
