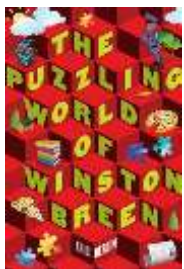

For children in grades 1-3 who love to read and would like to share stories, crafts, and treats. Registration is required.

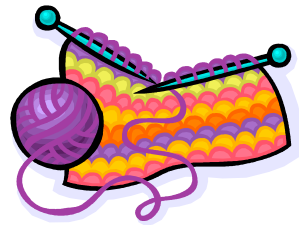


## February Special Events

### **Knitting and Crocheting Classes are Back!**

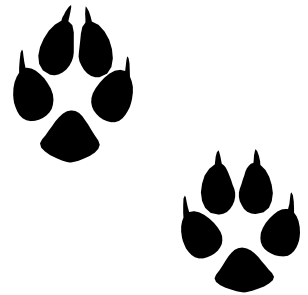
**Second Session: February 4, 11:00am**
