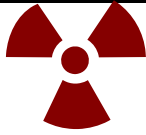

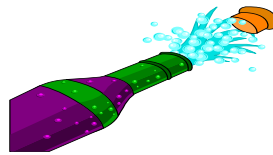
Market at Marquee

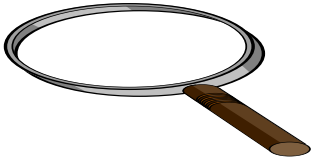
