

ORDINANCE NO. 297

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 58-252 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD, MICHIGAN TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO POSSESS IN A PUBLIC PLACE ANY AIR GUN, SLINGSHOT, BOWS AND ARROWS, OR OTHER SIMILAR DANGEROUS WEAPON UNLESS CARRIED UNLOADED OR CARRIED IN A SUITABLE CASE OR SECURELY WRAPPED UP IN A PACKAGE.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF REDFORD HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

1. Section 58-252 of the Code of Ordinances, Charter Township of Redford is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 58-252 Possession in public.

It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession, or in a motor vehicle which such person is operating or in which he is a passenger, while on any public street, road, highway, alley, park or other public place, any airgun, slingshot, bow and arrow, or other similar dangerous weapons, unless such airgun, ~~or~~ slingshot, or other similar dangerous weapon is carried unloaded ~~or unless and~~ such airgun, slingshot, ~~or~~ bow and arrow, or other similar dangerous weapon is carried in a suitable case or securely wrapped up in a package.

2. Repeal. All Ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

3. Savings Clause. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be immediately recorded by the Township Clerk, and shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in said Township within ten (10) days after its passage, and shall take effect immediately upon publication.
