Speakers must be recognized by the Chair & are required to report their full name, address & group affiliation, if and when appropriate. Speakers shall address all comments to the Chair & not to staff or other speakers or persons attending the meeting. Speakers shall generally be limited to making a three (3) minute statement; however, the Chair may reduce the time granted to speak whenever circumstances warrant, including the length of the Agenda, a large number of persons wishing to speak on the same issue or preventing the conclusion of a meeting at a reasonable time. The Chair may request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum or when the person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting, unless permission to continue or to again address the Planning Commission is granted by the majority vote of the Planning Commission members present.
